Bill Williams addressed the council concerning East Alabama Regional Planning Commission and stated that if anyone had any concerns to let him know and he would bring them before the commission.


Mayor Lewis stated that Henry Dunlap was almost finished with the audit and would see about getting the budget going after completion.



Judy Wilder made a motion to adjourn, Marie Lee second and all were in favor. The meeting ended at 7:10 p.m.









Mayor Lewis presented the council with a proposed budget for 2006 to include the sidewalk project and town hall roof.



Mike Fielding made a motion to adjourn and Margie Lee seconded. The meeting adjourned at 7:00 p.m.



Mayor Lewis called the meeting to order. The minutes from last months meeting were approved. The financial statements were discussed and approved.


Mayor Lewis presented the council with a color chart for the metal roofing. The council chose "clay" as the color for the roofing.







Mike Fielding made a motion to adjourn, Judy Wilder second and all were in favor. The meeting adjourned at 7:00.






Mike Fielding made a motion to increase all town employee salaries by \$2.00 per hour, Margie Lee second, all approved and the motion carried.

Raymond Abrams made a motion to adjourn, David Tuck second, all in favor. The meeting ended at 8:00 p.m.




Mayor Lewis called the meeting to order. The minutes from last months meeting were approved. The financial statements were discussed and approved.







ball field. Mike Fielding will check into alternative materials to use for the track. This issue was tabled until next month.



The meeting adjourned at 7:20.









Mayor Lewis expressed his appreciation to everyone who was involved in the Independence Celebration.


Mayor Lewis stated that before we put in a new sidewalk we need to make sure we work up a budget for it and the state needs to cut down the road.



Mayor Lewis called the meeting to order. The minutes from last months meeting were approved. The financial statements were discussed and approved.



Mayor Lewis said that the town needs to fix the pipe under the street at Jackson and Oak streets. Ursula will call Byron Stroud to come take a look.


The council discussed the old air unit and police car. These will be advertised for sealed bids.


Mayor Lewis requested permission from the town to purchase new flags for the median. The council approved this request.

Carel Smith asked the status of the drain situation at the old hardware store. Mayor Lewis said he would have Byron Stroud take a look at it and get back with us.


